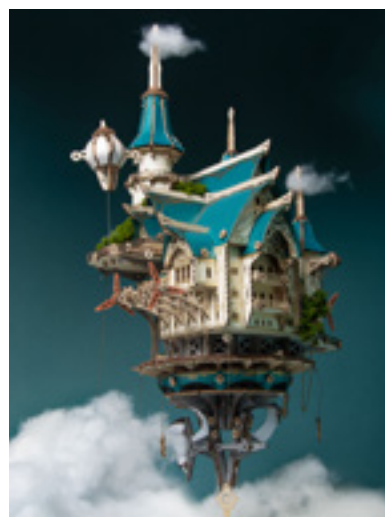

THE AUCKLAND HOME SHOW

has always brought the latest ideas for the home together in one place. This year, that thinking moves decisively outside. The new Auckland Garden Showcase transforms part of Auckland Showgrounds into an immersive collection of 11 landscaped gardens, outdoor-living zones and practical inspiration for backyards of every scale.

WHY A SHOWCASE rather than a conventional row of product stands? Gardens make most sense as complete environments. Planting, paving, retaining, decking, water, lighting, furniture, fire and shelter all work together, and seeing those elements at full scale makes it easier to understand how an idea could translate to your own property.

THE DISPLAYS RANGE from a compact small garden and a native pool zone to contemplative

landscapes, culturally inspired gardens and a polished entertaining courtyard. Alongside them, Mitre 10 presents a dedicated outdoor-living area and live BBQ masterclasses, while the Garden Hub brings plants, workshops and one-to-one advice into the same destination.

EACH DESIGNER GARDEN is built by official landscape partner Parrot Landscaping, with Kings Plant Barn and Awa Nursery supplying and dressing the planting, and Central Landscape Supplies and Firth providing the materials beneath it. The result is both inspirational and useful: a place to compare approaches, talk directly with designers and experts, and leave with a clearer picture of what could work at home.

The Auckland Garden Showcase turns 2,500 square metres into a walkthrough world of landscaping, planting and outdoor living.

Landscape gardener and Auckland Home Show Expert, David Rhodes of Parrot Landscaping has worked with some of NZ's top landscape architects to put the Auckland Garden Showcase together.

Raised timber decks and boardwalks lead through dense native planting to a round plunge pool, showing how water can become art of the garden even on smaller sections.

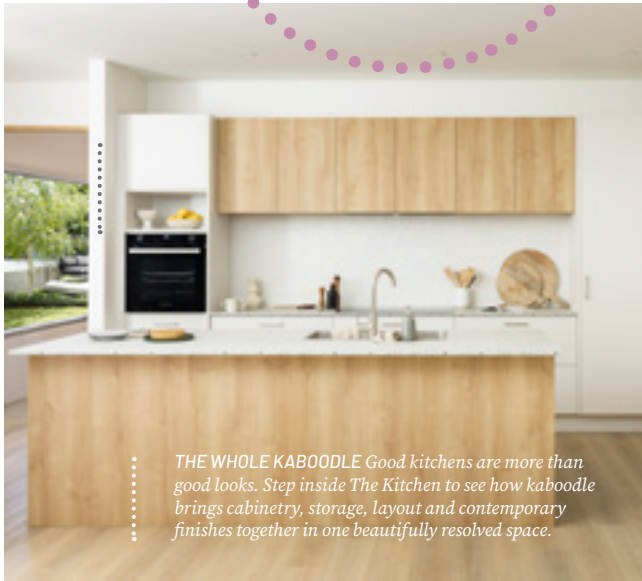

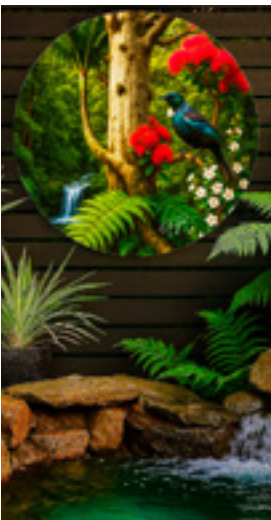

DR GARETH GRETTON is a lead advisor in the Evidence, Insights and Innovation team at EECA (the Energy Efficiency and Conservation Authority). His work includes a major focus on NZ's existing homes, and he leads research to better understand the energy efficiency, carbon, health, and wellbeing impacts of retrofit.

GARETH GRETTON EXPERT Q&A

What's the latest project you've been working on, and what makes it interesting?

I've been part of a team at EECA working on research into what New Zealand's future energy system could look like. It's a huge data model, but it translates into everyday decisions like how we build and renovate our homes today. It suggests in 20 years, your home could be warmer, largely electric, and smart enough to use energy when it's cheapest and most abundant. That means lower power bills, and more comfortable homes.

What's inspired you this year?

I went to Fieldays this year with our 'Solar on farms' team, and when I got to explore, I was really impressed with the quality and range of transportable homes on offer – all price points, all sizes, and some of which included whole-home ventilation systems, so they're thinking about that from the get-go.

What's a big topic in your world right now – something you think homeowners should be thinking about?

Our electricity system is going to get smarter, and our homes will become active players in it, instead of passively receiving power. Our appliances, including solar, EVs and batteries, will be able to talk to each other and the grid, to turn

power up and down as needed, and when it's cheapest. That's going to avoid billions of dollars in building unnecessary

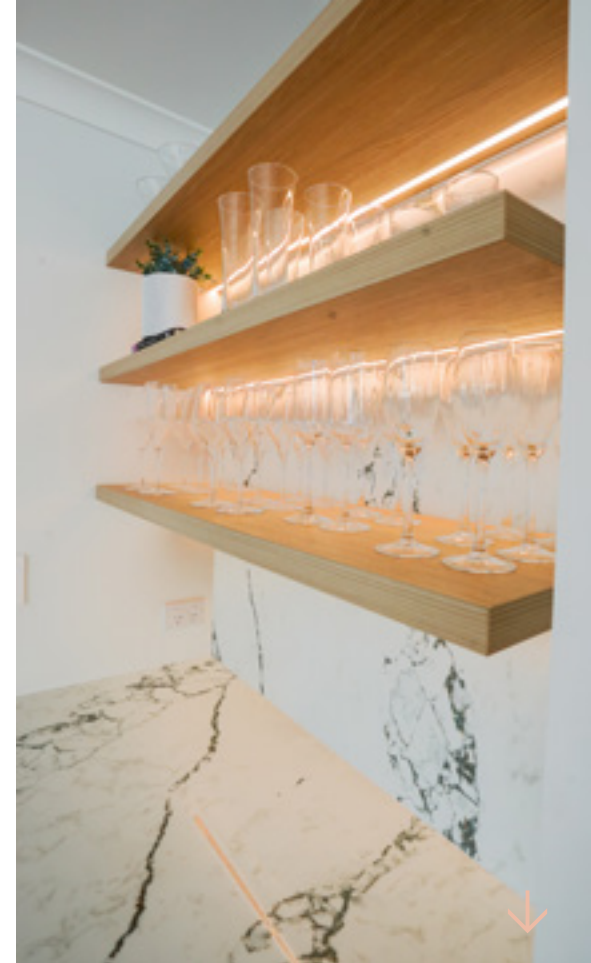

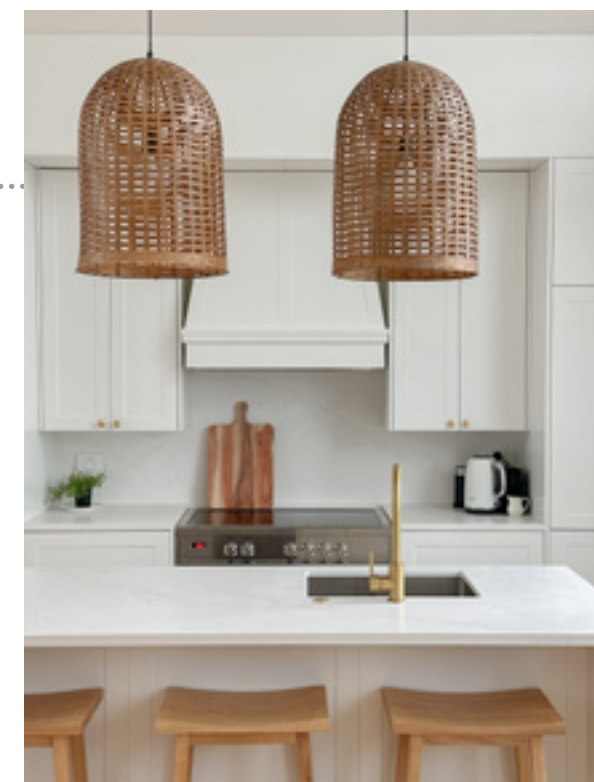

KELLY GAMMIE is an interior designer at Rarebirds Interiors. She helps clients make braver design choices, stay sane through the design and build journey, and create spaces that feel wonderful to live, work or eat in.

KELLY GAMMIE EXPERT Q&A

What's the latest project you've been working on, and what makes it interesting?

Rarebirds are lucky enough to be working on numerous interesting projects at present. We have a couple of large beachside new builds where we are an essential part of the architectural design team, helping to shape our clients' homes from the very early stages. These builds are embracing materials we don't often see used in New Zealand, such as textural blockwork and oodles of natural stone cladding. We also have several large renovations requiring clever spatial planning solutions, which for me is one of the most interesting aspects of interior design. Our clients enable us to be creative and deliver designs that are fun and boundary-pushing – we're lucky designers.

What's inspired you this year?

Travelling 3000km up and down the West Australian coast with my ocean-loving daughter was truly inspiring – except for the flies, of course. The clarity of colour in that region is almost overwhelming. Rich ochres and terracotta-hued sands smashing into bright blue water was so joyful. I have always loved using warm colour palettes, but I can see beautiful, bold blues creeping into several interior schemes recently, absolutely inspired by that Indian Ocean scenery.

What's a big topic in your world right now – something you think homeowners should be thinking about?

Telling your own story through your home's interior is probably the strongest topic in interior design at the moment – not just following set 'looks'. The use of colour and texture isn't going away, just getting stronger and richer, and the appreciation of craftspeople and their creations is increasing in the interior design language of many great design studios.

What's one thing people commonly get wrong when planning a renovation project?

Not understanding the full picture of building or renovating, and not including ALL the costs. People forget to add the cost of curtains, blinds, rugs, furniture or extra objects you may need to make it a

home. More often than not, they are the elements a building company or architect doesn't include in their spreadsheets to you.

What's the one piece of advice you wish every client knew before they came to you?

Engage an experienced designer early in your build journey – a professional who can add tangible value to your build or renovation and make the journey much easier. Many of our clients have engaged us as the first professional on their team. Some, though, I wish had come earlier in the process, before plans went to council or before a builder ripped apart their home and important decisions weren't confirmed.

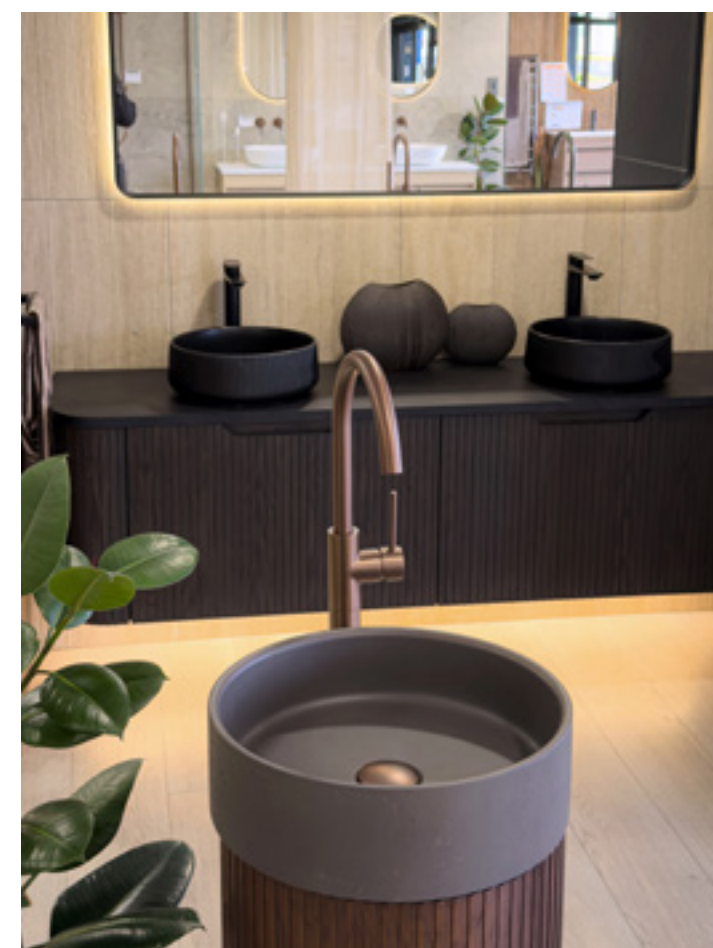

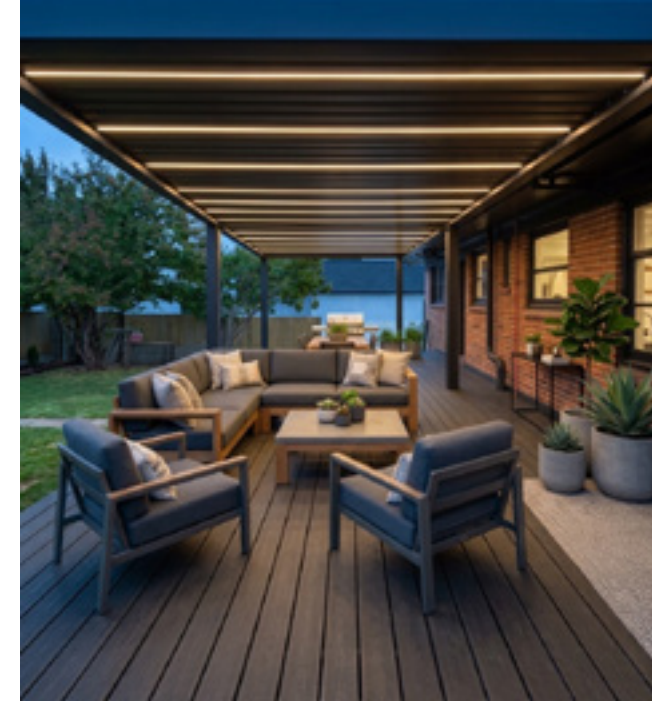

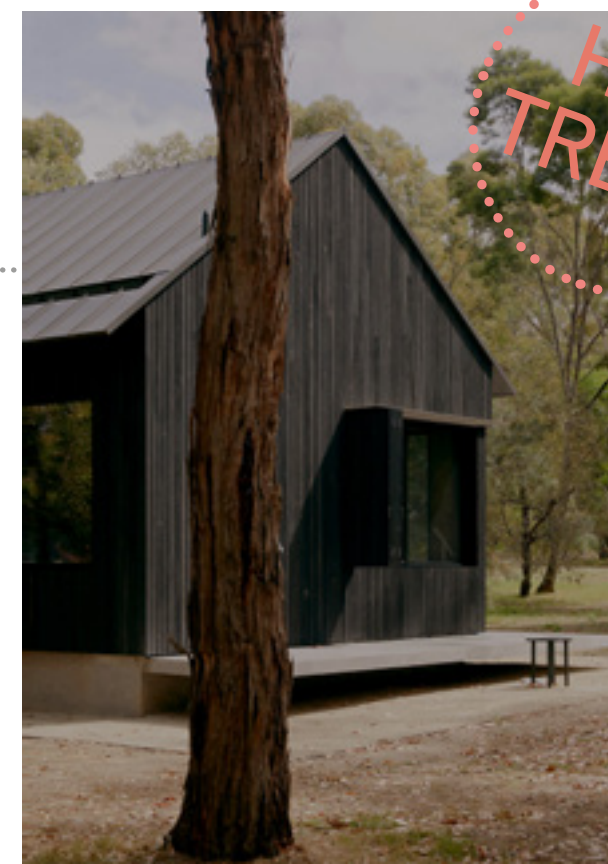

FEATURED HOME SHOW RENOVATION EXPERT



What's the latest project you've been working on, and what makes it interesting?

No two renovations are the same. We're renovating for an older couple who saw me at the Home Show a year ago and came to our seminar. A year later they contacted us, and we started their renovation a couple of weeks ago. It's a complete renovation – kitchen, bathrooms, new roof, the lot. They were quite nervous initially, but they just absolutely love it. They're living in the garage while we renovate the house. It's pretty cool.

What's inspired you this year?

What's inspired me massively is the growth of my team and my young apprentices. I've got three awesome apprentices. One knocked on the door about eight months ago because he couldn't get a job, and he's just absolutely fantastic. These young people absolutely inspire me. That's what keeps me going – being able to pass my skills, knowledge and workmanship on to the young team.

What's a big topic in your world right now – something you think homeowners should be thinking about?

Do your due diligence. Understand what is not in the quote. Don't believe all the hype, the Facebook, the gloss and all that. Talk to real people, ring up your references and go and see some builders' work. Don't just rely on everything you hear or read. If you're renovating, use a specialist renovation company. Do your homework before you start.

What's one thing people commonly get wrong when planning a renovation project?

They don't always take into account what the existing structure looks like. One thing always leads on to another. A new kitchen is great, but you need to look at the big picture of everything. People can be all about the finish – the fancy kitchen, bathroom, doorknobs and tiles – but not the structure, maintenance, sustainability, double glazing and insulation.

What's the one piece of advice you wish every client knew before they came to you?

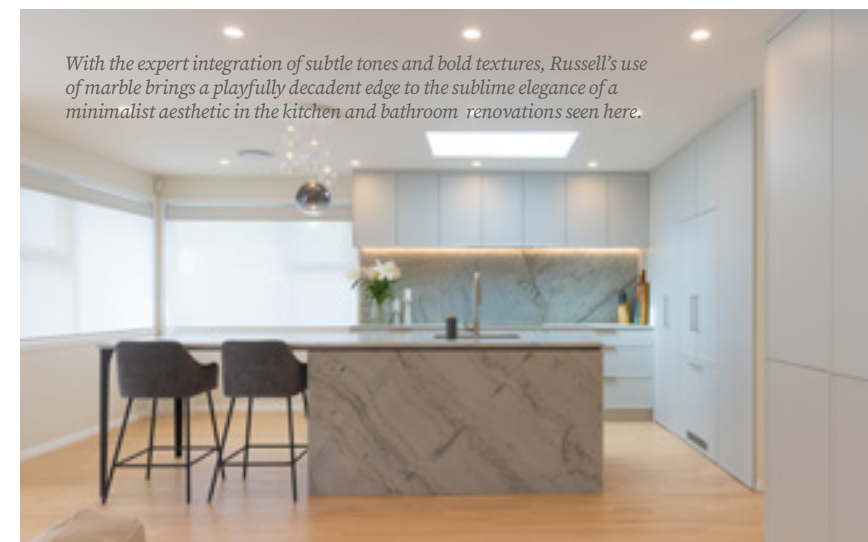
Know your budget, or have an idea of your budget, and don't be afraid to tell us so that we're all on the same wavelength. Be open and get that trust with your builder first. Just be honest with the builder who's going to work with you, not against you.

What's the latest project you've been working on, and what makes it interesting?

We've recently been transforming a challenging Auckland property in Remuera into a complete outdoor living environment, incorporating retaining, a large consented deck and laminated structural systems, improved access, retaining and paving zones, planting and irrigation. Consented structures can sometimes feel visually dominant, so one of the many aspects was to work closely with the client and our in-house design team to soften everything, ensuring everything feels practical, cohesive and well established.

What's inspired you this year?

I've been particularly inspired by naturalistic planting and the way thoughtful plant selection can soften architecture, create atmosphere and make a property feel as though it truly belongs in its surroundings.

What's a big topic in your world right now – something you think homeowners should be thinking about?

Resilient landscape design is increasingly important. Auckland properties need outdoor spaces that manage heavy rainfall effectively while also coping with hotter, drier periods. We're working with more stormwater management, water conservation and recycling systems to maximise the potential of each landscape while helping protect properties from flooding, slips and significant land movement caused by extreme weather

What's one thing people commonly get wrong when planning a landscaping project?

People often treat landscaping as the final part of a build or renovation. Involving a landscape professional early creates stronger connections between the house and garden, avoids costly compromises and can uncover opportunities that might otherwise be missed.

What's the one piece of advice you wish every client knew before they came to you?



Texture, natural materials and considered detail are shaping New Zealand interiors in 2026. Across furniture, finishes and window treatments, one idea keeps surfacing: rooms are being built up in layers rather than decorated in a single stroke. Timber, stone, woven fibre and soft upholstery are being combined for depth and warmth, with lighting and fine detail now doing as much work as colour ever did.
